## LOGITECH WIRELESS SOLAR KEYBOARD K750 FOR MAC®

Love Apple's wireless Bluetooth keyboard but fed up of buying new batteries? Logitech's new K750 keyboard could be the answer: a wireless keyboard — complete with a numeric keypad — powered entirely by the sun, which is sure to save you a small fortune and help the environment.

The K750 looks fantastic, in fact, if it didn't have that Logitech logo on it, you'd be forgiven for thinking it was made by Apple themselves. It looks identical to Apple's wireless aluminum keyboard, and features all the same function keys, but also boasts a whole lot more.

Just like Apple's own keyboard, you have function keys for easy access to brightness and volume controls, Dashboard, Expose, and Mission Control. Unlike Apple's offering, however, this device also packs a numeric keypad, and doesn't need new batteries every couple of weeks.

Powered entirely by ambient light, the K750 will run for up to three months in complete darkness from a full charge, and Logitech says even regular indoor light is enough to keep it ticking over. So unless you plan to work in complete darkness for more than 3 months, you should never have to worry about the K750 giving up on you mid-report.

But solar power isn't its only environmentally friendly gloat, the K750 also has a PVC-free construction and packaging that's completely recyclable.

To accompany the device, Logitech promises to launch a free application for your Mac that will allow you to monitor its energy levels, and will alert you when it needs more light. What's more, the included 2.4GHz wireless receiver uses Logitech's Unifying technology, which lets you use a single USB dongle for multiple Logitech input devices.

The K750 will be available later this month for \$60.





## ***Installing LION 10.7***

***Warning*** you will loose all your POWER PC applications, LION runs on INTEL only applications. I installed Lion and lost about 35 old power pc apps. Apple Works, file Maker 7, Quicken, Adobe Photo 7, Now up to Date, many old games that I had, A lot of the old apps are available in new programs, that means more money \$\$\$\$ which probably is good to update for new features. I think I would buy the USB Thumb Drive as choice next time. The download takes anout 30-45minutes plus install about 45 minutes. The thumb drive hooks up and installs in about 45 minutes plus then you have to go in and set most of your preferences in your programs you use, some of mine did not transfer over, no problem just takes time, about two-half hours.

The other way around this so far is to PARTITION your hard-drive. Keep LION on one part and SNOW LEOPARD on the other part. This must be done before you install LION. Lion will take some time to get to know the new operating system. It has a lot of newfeatures. Some of the old features can be restored as I mentioned above. The function keys act a little different now. I may not have mine set up like I want yet , I will get there. You can purchase LION from the app store for **\$29.99 as a digital download.**

OS X Lion is the next major release of the Mac operating system and includes over 250 new features that will transform how you interact with your Mac. Tap, swipe, and scroll your way through your apps using fluid Multi-Touch gestures. Full-screen apps take advantage of every pixel of your display. Mission Control gives you a birds-eye view of everything running on your Mac and makes it easy to navigate anywhere with a click. Launchpad gives you instant

access to all the apps on your Mac. And a completely redesigned Mail app features powerful new search capabilities and groups messages into Conversations.
